- Hunting Reminder Deer Hunting sign-ups will be held at the September Open Meeting on Wednesday, September 8<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. If you plan to sign-up, please bring your hunting license along with your membership card with work stamps. If you cannot attend this meeting, you must provide a written letter to the board of directors wishing to participate in the hunting privilege. You must have obtained at least 16 hours of service work before September and be a member in good standing for at least two (2) years.
  - NOTE: If using a tree stand on club grounds it must be marked with your name and phone number.
- Wearing of the Orange The STFSA Board is requiring that all members not legally hunting on the club grounds during big game hunting seasons, October 2<sup>nd</sup> thru January 17<sup>th</sup>, wear at least a fluorescent orange hat and we strongly recommend meeting the PA Game Commission required fluorescent orange requirements. • Our pond took a serious step back in August of 2020. The spring dried up and 75% of our fish perished. Since then, the spring started flowing again and in late winter of this year we started making improvements to the pond. We are trying to remove the Iris plants on road side of the pond creating more habitat on the far side. We are also working on getting a fish count of what survived. In July, we stocked 8 Asian grass carp to try reduce the underwater vegetation. We will continue to work on the pond to get it back on track.
